Any one of the two alternatives set below may be selected.

A. Objects Required:

An Electric Iron (for ironing clothes), a mug and a few crumpled clothes.

Arrange all the items on a wooden board in a close grouping to depict that ironing of clothes is about to take place.

B. Objects Required:

A tall flower vase, 2 or 3 cut flowers of your choice, a basket and a pair of scissors.

Stand the empty vase to one side. Put the flowers in a shallow basket with the pair of scissors in front of the basket. Stand the basket to one side and at an angle to the vase. The scene should look as if flowers are about to be arranged in the vase.
